SUMMER SAFETY PROTOCOLS

TK- 6TH GRADE



DROP OFF PROCEDURE

K- 6th Grade Students

- * Use upper parking lot.
- * Parents must remain inside vehicles.
- * Students walk to designated social distancing spots & await turn at designated area by gate.
- * **TK Students** park on street in front of school & use lower parking lot. (No driving into lot).
- * **TK & Elementary Students** who have siblings in the preschool must enter from the lower parking lot.

TEMPERATURE CHECK

Active Screening takes place

- * Temperature check
 - * Basic Covid-19 symptom overall visual check.
 - * Children get hand sanitizer and walk into building.
- At entry, any children displaying any symptoms associated with Covid-19 will not be allowed into school. *Pls do not leave the parking lot until your child gains entry to school.*
- During the school day, children exhibiting any symptoms will be isolated immediately and must be picked up within 15- 20 minutes. Child must stay home for a minimum of 10 days until symptoms have improved & are free of fever for at least 24 hrs without fever reducing medication.

PICK UP PROCEDURE

Adults must wear masks at all times & use **same entrances**. Adults must use walkway and stay on social distancing spots. Staff will use Walkie Talkies to send children out to meet parents.

WELCOME BACK FAMILIES

We are looking forward to gradually getting back to 'normal' welcoming back all families; old as well as new. We are confident and eager to forge ahead and get started, so welcome back everyone! We are so excited to meet and greet again and have prepared a very exciting Summer Camp for all our elementary students. Most of our students had the opportunity to come back on campus in March; however, some didn't, so we hope all students will return in the summer for some good ol' fashion fun!

FEWER RESTRICTIONS

LA County Dept of Public Health has deemed that LA County has met the metrics to ease restrictions; however, schools must remain compliant with State Guidance. We will continue to abide by all the layers of mitigation & strategies we have implemented as it restricts the spread of Covid in schools. They are listed here; since none of our students are vaccinated we need all families to comply with the protocols unconditionally to ensure the health & safety for all. Thank You for your utmost cooperation.

MASKS

All students must wear a mask at all times, except during meal time. All Oneonta staff members will wear a mask at all times on campus. Extra masks may be brought (in backpack) to school. If masks tear or get dirty, school will provide one. A little personal paper bag with child's name will be provided so masks can be stored when not in use.

SNACKS/ LUNCHES

Snacks and lunches must be brought from home. All food items must be kept inside backpack inside the classroom (TK-6th grade students) and in lunch boxes (preschool). Sharing of food is not allowed at school.

WATER BOTTLES

All drinking fountains are no longer operational; disposable water bottles or thermoses must be brought from home. All items brought from home must be kept inside backpacks all day (TK-6th grade students), and inside cubbies (preschool).

SOCIAL DISTANCING

We will make sure every student is cognizant & upholds this rule. There are designated markings on the floor inside the school as well as outside on the playground; students must await their turn by standing on these markings.

At Drop off and pick up we ask that parents also stay on the markings and only move up when spots becomes available.

If anyone other than those on the Emergency pick up list arrives to pick up your child, please let the class teacher know ahead of time.

SAFETY STANDARDS

CLASSROOMS

Children will remain mainly with their own class group all day. Classrooms have been restructured & configured to maintain social distancing; desks/tables are laid out across the room to ensure social distancing.

OUTDOOR RECESS

Each class will have outdoor time during recess, lunch & daycare. Children will be closely monitored by staff; class groups will stay & play together. Play structures will be disinfected after each group uses the play ground.

LOCKER AREA IS CLOSED

Students are not allowed to use the lockers. **Backpacks are mandatory &** all items brought to school must fit inside and kept inside their own classrooms.

INSIDE BACKPACKS

Snacks: morning and afternoon
Lunch
Water bottles
Personal Hand sanitizer
Extra Masks

COVID-19 SYMPTOMS + CHILDHOOD DISEASES

Please make sure all children come to school not exhibiting any type of symptoms, even a slight case of the sniffles. Staff conducting wellness check will ask that child be taken home.

VISITORS NOT ALLOWED

No one other than Oneonta staff & service personnel will be allowed on campus. ***Please refrain from gathering in the parking lot or on the street in groups so as to adhere to social distancing guidelines.***

PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE!

CAMP STARTS AT: 9:00 A.M. – TK- 6TH GRADE

We ask that all our students be in school by 9:00 a.m. the latest. Our summer program is jam packed with activities that have been scheduled to start on time. Please make sure that children are in school and inside their classrooms by 9:00 a.m., set & ready to begin the day. Thank You!

DAY CARE HOURS

To limit time on campus, our daycare hours have been shortened this school year; **Start time is 7:00 a.m. and closing time 5:00 p.m. daily.** Please do not be late as the late fee is \$1.00 per minute past 5:00 p.m., payable to the teacher who stays with the children until pick up.

HAND WASHING

Children will be supervised with hand washing at numerous intervals throughout the school day. Hand washing must be for a duration of 20 seconds; using napkin to shut off faucet.

HAND SANITIZER STATIONS

Numerous stations have been installed all around the school; classroom entrances, hallways and under patios. Children will use hand sanitizer whenever they pass these stations, supervised by the staff.

RESTROOMS

Class groups will take turns to use the restroom. For emergency use, only 1 student per class will have access.

TRAVEL

According to the CDC guidelines, all persons (any child, family or staff member) returning from vacation from any other state or another country must not return to school until a 10 day mandatory self quarantine period has lapsed. Three days after arrival, if a Covid19 test is conducted and it is a negative result, individual may come back to school after the 7th day of arrival. We ask that everyone, please comply with this guideline so that all of us at Oneonta can remain healthy. Thank you for your cooperation!

CELL PHONES & ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Students are not allowed to bring any of the above as they are not needed during summer camp. Students will not be assigned work on any electronic device in the summer.

DISINFECTING SCHOOL/CLASSROOMS

We have always used a professional janitorial company to clean and sanitize our school on a daily basis. They will continue to do so with an emphasis on disinfecting all high touch common areas such as door knobs, light switches gates etc on a daily basis. Staff is in charge of disinfecting tables, chairs, daycare toy bins, materials & other high touch areas in their own classrooms at the end of each day.

SAFETY FIRST - STAY AT HOME POLICY

We are glad that the metrics used by the LACDPH allows for fewer restrictions beginning June 15th. However, our students are not vaccinated and we must do everything to protect them. We must not let our guard down and ask that parents be vigilant and notify us immediately if any student, or any of their family members, develops symptoms and/or tests positive for COVID-19. It is imperative we follow CDC guidelines about what must then take place. The student, any siblings, and possibly their classmates, will then stay home for a period of 10 days of self quarantine. They may only return to Campus when they have completed the 10 day quarantine period. Please understand the broad implications of the situation and inform us immediately so we can take the necessary steps at school to ensure the safety of our student body and Oneonta staff. Thank You for your utmost co-operation!
