IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT SUMMER CAMP

Be on time for school every day; the fun starts at 9:00 sharp. Activities are planned ahead of time and ready to start. Please don't be late! Thank you!

WHAT TO WEAR

Children need to come to school dressed in comfortable clothing; t-shirts and shorts/pants. Socks and closed shoes work best for playing outside. Sandals and flip flips must not be worn as they pose a safety hazard when running.

Please apply sunscreen at home before coming to school and send a hat/cap to school so children can wear it during recess. Children will not use the yard when it is very hot, 90 degrees or over.

ALLERGIES

Please notify teachers on the first day of summer camp if your child has any allergies. It is very important that we are all aware.

STAFF VACATIONS

Summer is the time of year that our staff is able to take vacations; please understand if your child's regular teacher may not be in her class for a few weeks. Another staff member will be assigned to substitute during her vacation. Lead teachers will prep everything that is needed to make sure their class functions smoothly before leaving on vacation.
