DROP OFF

- Parents must park on the street & walk up to the tent for check in at gate.
- After a welcome & pump of hand sanitizer, staff will walk children into their respective classrooms.
- Make sure to give your child a big hug and kiss before leaving.
- Parents are not allowed inside the school.



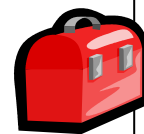
PICK UP

- Use the buzzer to announce arrival.

- Only authorized persons may pick up children.
- Please make sure to inform the school if anyone else is picking child up.



WHAT CHILDREN NEED EVERY DAY

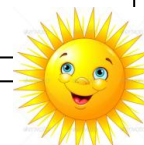
- Reusable water bottle
- Lunch & snack in lunch box
- Sunscreen (applied at home)
- Cap or hat
- Running shoes. No sandals or flip flops
- Rollee Pollee blankets to be kept in school all week & taken home every Friday for washing.



ON VERY HOT DAYS

When temperature exceeds 90 degrees, or if there is a lot of smog/smoke children will stay indoors.

- Children may go outside to play in the late afternoon when temperatures are cooler. They will be encouraged to play in the shade or under the patio.
- Children will be encouraged to drink lots of water throughout the day.



SUMMER CURRICULUM

Our summer curriculum is planned ahead of time for the 8 fun weeks of summer school. New students will be gradually eased into a regular classroom routine and introduced to group activities, games & the Montessori materials which they will work on independently. Older children will sharpen Language, Math and printing skills as a preparation for the Pre K, TK & Kindergarten. Classrooms will have weekly schedules with daily activities listed; sent out via the DOJO app; be sure to check out all the fun activities planned for every week.
