DROP - OFF & PICK - UP

- **Drop Off**; Parents must drive to the upper parking lot (only) for drop off and pick up.

WHAT CHILDREN NEED EVERY DAY

 Lunch & snack (disposable items are highly recommended)



- We are unable to warm up any lunches.
- Water fountains are turned off so at least 2 bottles of water per day are required.
